




Specialization criteria



Protocol and Events Management

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

Practicum II

- -The minimum number of hours in the company is 225 and the maximum 900 (in each academic year)
- -The Practicum can be done between July 2024 and July 2025.
- -It must be linked to the specialization you have chosen

Enrollment regulations

-Enrollment: July 2024 (online)

- -Course load regulations
 - ✓ If you have passed all the subjects, you can enroll 60 new credits
 - ✓ If you have failed some subjects, you can enroll 60 new credits + the number of credits corresponding to the subjects not passed (maximum 75 credits in an academic year). In this case, you must first enroll in the subjects not passed and then add the subjects for the next year.




