

In the case of Tourism or Culinary & Gastronomic Sciences Degree students, they can choose between doing an exchange with another university, international internship in a company or finish the degree doing the Senior Capstone Project with an international company.

For those who have recently graduated, there is the possibility of undertaking a Minor program. These type of programs are aimed to provide a specialization in a concrete field after finishing the 4-years degree.

CHOOSING A DESTINATION

Academic

CETT-UB offers more than 50 international agreements all around the world, and keeps working every year to create new ones. The academic recognition and transfer of credits studied at the host university is guaranteed, provided that the courses have been previously agreed and approved by CETT-UB before the start of the mobility and these enrolled courses the host university are passed.

If you are interested in studying in a **university from the national territory**, the program SICUE allows all the students in the Spanish area to do a semester or one year at another university. This type of programs are compatible with the other exchange programs (as long as they do not overlap).

If you are planning on doing an **exchange within Europe**, Erasmus+ is a program focused on the international mobility within the countries of the European Union.

Finally, if you would like to go further, CETT-UB offers to possibility to study abroad at **universities in the rest of the world** through GLOBAL FACULTY UB. Thanks to this program, you will be able to discover countries from Asia, North & South America, and Oceania...

In all these options, students have to be enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree at CETT-UB during the academic year in which the student exchange is done. They are exempt from paying the tuition fee at the host university. Nonetheless, in some cases students may be required to pay compulsory fees for insurances, students' unions, access to university services, etc.

Internship

It is also possible to do internships in international companies, either for both of the compulsory curricular internships or for extra-curricular internships. All undergraduate students can do the internship (at the CETT-UB, in Catalonia, in Spain or abroad) as long as it is related to their degree and/or mention of studies of each student.

The destination offers vary according to the companies interested and/or the time of year; you can find offers from national territory to European or outside Europe.

If you are interested in doing the internship in Catalonia or another community within the Spanish State, the CETT-UB offers a wide range of companies for all the degree mentions. If you prefer to look for an international company, you will find all the offers available in the international Work Placement in the Student Guide.

On the other hand, there is the possibility for students of looking for a company not offered by the CETT-UB with whom they can carry out the internship. In this case, a new agreement will have to be created taking into account that, if it takes place outside the Spanish State, an independent health insurance will have to be contracted through the UB (the cost does not reach 100€). In the case of non-EU students, it is important to keep the NIE in effect.

SICUE

The SICUE (System of Exchange between Spanish University Centers) is an academic mobility program established by the Conference of Rectors of Spanish Universities. Through this program, students from Spanish universities can carry out part of their studies at any of the other Spanish university with which their university has an agreement, with the guarantee of academic recognition and achievement, as well as an adaptation to their curricular profile.

SICUE is compatible with other exchange programs as long as they do not overlap at the same time. Students will only be allowed to carry out one SICUE exchange per year and per Host University.

This type of exchange can be from one semester (5 months) to an academic course (9 months)

Available locations

CETT-UB has agreement with 9 universities distributed within the national territory, with 13 available places. They offer exchanges with autonomous communities such as Madrid, Valencia (Alicante), Catalonia (Tarragona), Balearic Islands (Majorca), Canary Islands (Tenerife), Andalusia (Malaga), Asturias (Oviedo) and Castilla & Leon (Salamanca)

International Mobility Application


Students must have a minimum of 45 ECTS credits passed and must be enrolled in the 2020-2021 academic year in no less than 30 ECTS credits, in order to be able to apply for the exchange.

The application will be carried out at the local university, CETT-UB, following all the steps that you will find in the Student's Guide and by strictly respecting all the deadlines when uploading the documents required.

Scholarships and Grants

SICUE mobility has historically been linked to Seneca scholarship, but since the 2013/2014 academic year, Seneca scholarship is not granted anymore. In this sense, the expenses of this type of mobility are borne by the student.

ERASMUS + STUDIES

Erasmus+ international program offers the opportunity to European students of studying in another university within the European Union and with the transcript of academic records guaranteed once the exchange has finished.

The mobility period is mainly for one semester only. It is possible to extend the exchange period one more semester with the approval of both (home and host) universities. It is only possible to apply for one semester in the yearly call for applications and the exchange period extension can only be done within the same academic year.

Available locations

CETT-UB has agreement with 23 universities distributed within 13 countries around the European territory, with more than 90 available places. They offer exchanges with countries such as Germany, Austria, Belgium, Finland, France, Italy, Lithuania, Norway, The Netherlands, Portugal, Romania, Switzerland o Turkey.

International Mobility Application

Beca Erasmus Estudis (Erasmus +): You have it granted if you have and Erasmus exchange slot awarded, you must correctly complete the steps as defined by SOP to be able to receive the scholarship payments. (link not available in English)


Beca Mou-te! de la Fundació Gaspar-España: Intended to promote the mobility and internationalization of students for the partial realization of university studies abroad in one of the partner universities of CETT-UB.

Beca Santander Erasmus: If you have an Erasmus slot assigned you can apply for the Santander scholarships for Erasmus.

Beca AGAUR - MOBINT: Grant for students of Catalan universities who have been selected for an academic mobility period, this scholarship contributes to the financing of the expenses involved in carrying out studies in other countries. It is managed by Agency for Management of University and Research Grants, which depends on the Generalitat de Catalunya (Catalan regional government). (link only available in Catalan or Spanish).

GLOBAL FACULTY UB

This type of program allows students to carry out an academic exchange with universities outside the national territory and different from the ones offered at Erasmus+, through Global Faculty UB between the host and the local university.

The mobility period is mainly for one semester only. It is possible to extend the exchange period one more semester with the approval of both (home and host) universities. It is only possible to apply for one semester in the yearly call for applications and the exchange period extension can only be done within the same academic year.

In this specific case, the academic records transcript can be more complex as the academic evaluation system may be different according to the destination. However, the student will have the transcript guaranteed.

Available locations

CETT-UB has agreement with 25 universities distributed within 14 countries around the world, with more than 80 available places. They offer exchanges with countries such as Canada, The United States of America, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Peru, Ecuador, Russia, Malaysia, Australia, Thailand, China, Hong Kong and South Korea.

International Mobility Application

Scholarships and Grants

INTERNATIONAL END-OF-DEGREE PROJECT

The Senior Capstone Project can also be done abroad with the collaboration of an international company. In this specific case, the student will be the one in charge of finding possible companies that may be interested on having them during the development of the SCP.

Students will have complete freedom when deciding the company that they are interested in (it must be related to their field of studies) and the subject they want to develop. This is a great opportunity to get to know the tourism or gastronomic sector in another country, enrich your curriculum vitae, and live an international experience linked to your academic and professional life. Besides, you can specialize on a concrete field thanks to the possibility to choose the project theme according to your interests.

The agreement must be accepted by both parties, the host company and CETT-UB. Without the permission of the local university, the student won't be able to carry out the Senior Capstone Project with the desired company.

MINOR PROGRAMS

Academic Minors are designed for students to explore and strengthen their understanding of specialized fields of knowledge. Minors comprise sets of courses that may be linked thematically or that have an international focus to complement their field of study. These programs draw on classes in a variety of disciplines to provide concentrated clusters of knowledge that enhance undergraduate degree programs

This international enhancement will add intangible value, interdisciplinary skills and intercultural management abilities to the undergraduate degree, setting students apart from other candidates in future professional or academic opportunities.

Minors are equivalent to 30 ECTS and students receive a specialized certificate from the host institution.

Minor Application

Finalizing students of the Bachelor's Degree in Tourism or Bachelor's Degree in Culinary and Gastronomic Sciences with all required courses enrolled will be eligible for the Minors Programs. Students are required to have passed 240 ECTS credits at the start of the program at the host institution.

Go Abroad Fair

Every year, the Go Abroad fair takes place in order to inform their students and alumni about the international academic and professional mobility offered. Along the day, all the options such as internship, minors, ERASMUS+ and others, are explained.

Furthermore, the students also receive information about the process of application, the benefits of being enrolled in an international experience and the possible destinations. It is a great opportunity for those students who don't know where to go, as every university will be represented by CETT-UB students that have already been there or exchange students from the host university who are currently studying here.
