FOR THE BEST FINAL PROJECTS WITH ENTREPRENEURIAL FOCUS

ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027



Purpose of the award

CETT Fundació, in its commitment to promoting entrepreneurship, innovation and self-employment, wants to recognize the best final projects developed by CETT students that stand out for their entrepreneurial nature and their potential to generate new business or professional initiatives.

With this initiative, CETT Fundació wants to stimulate the development of entrepreneurial and self-employment projects that are innovative, viable and capable of adding value to the areas of tourism, hospitality, gastronomy, food, nutrition, marketing, events and other related sectors.

Eligibility

The award is aimed at CETT students who have presented and passed a Final Degree Project (TFG), a Final Master's Project (TFM) or a final project of a Higher Education Training Cycle (CFGS) with an entrepreneurial and/or self-employment orientation.

To be eligible for the award, projects must have obtained a final grade of 8 or higher.

How to apply

Candidates must fill out the participation form available on the CETT Fundació website.

The deadline for submitting applications is **July 12, 2027, at 11:59 PM**

When submitting the application, the report of the TFG, TFM or Final Project of the Training Cycle must be attached.

Participation in this call is compatible with the presentation of the CETT Fundació Academic Excellence Awards. In the event of being a winner in both calls, the awards will be cumulative.

Participation in the award implies full acceptance of these rules.

Jury

The jury will be made up of members of the management teams of CETT and CETT Fundació, professionals, entrepreneurs and leading specialists in the fields of entrepreneurship, tourism, hospitality, gastronomy and related sectors.

The projects will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Innovation and originality of the proposal.
- Technical quality and rigor of the project.
- Contribution of value to the sector.
- Viability and development potential.
- Impact and capacity to generate professional or business opportunities.

The jury reserves the right to declare any of the awards void if no candidature is submitted or if it considers that the projects presented do not reach the required level of quality, innovation or excellence.

The jury's verdict will be final.

Selection process

Stage I

A technical committee appointed by CETT Fundació will review the applications received and select the finalist projects in accordance with the criteria established in these award guideline.

Only the candidates selected to participate in the final phase will be notified of the result.

Stage II

The finalists must present and defend their project before the jury in a face-to-face or virtual session, in accordance with the calendar established for each type of project. The jury session will take place on July 22, 2027.

Once the presentations have been completed, the jury will issue its verdict and determine the awarded projects.

The award

The aim of the prizes is to promote the development of selected projects, promoting their validation, consolidation, and/ or implementation.

A prize will be awarded for each of the following categories:

- Bachelor's Degree Final Project (TFG).
- Master's Degree Final Project (TFM).
- Final Project of a Higher Education Training Cycle (CFGs).

The award is for the project regardless of whether it has one or more authors.

The awards will be presented at CETT at the CETT Fundació Entrepreneurship Conference scheduled for November 19th, 2027.

The awarded projects will receive:

- Outstanding participation in the CETT 2027 Entrepreneurship Conference, which will take place on November 19th 2027.
- Mentoring and specialized support program from October 4, 2027, to June 2028..
- Access to a specialized training program in entrepreneurship and self-employment.
- Free assistance to the activities developed within the entrepreneurial ecosystem of CETT and CETT Fundació.
- Access to business project incubation services from February 2028, subject to assessment of the project and its specific needs.

With the aim of recognizing and promoting female entrepreneurship, FIDEM may grant special recognition to any of the winning applications that correspond to projects promoted by women or led by a woman, even if they have been developed by mixed teams. This distinction aims to foster the entrepreneurial spirit among students, support emerging talent and promote the values of leadership, innovation and social commitment among young women.

Dissemination rights

Participants authorize CETT Fundació to disseminate information regarding the awarded and finalist projects through its communication and dissemination channels, always stating the authorship of the works. This authorization does not imply the transfer of intellectual property rights over the projects presented.
